The Senate resumed the consideration of the motion by Mr. Lansdale, to take up the Metropolitan Railroad bill,

Decided in the affirmative.

Mr. Tome moved to re-commit it,

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Ohr submitted the following amendment:

Amend section 13, by adding thereto the following: "*Provided*, That the said Metropolitan Railroad Company shall pay to the Treasury of the State of Maryland, on the first Wednesday of January and July, in each and every year for the use of the State, one-fifth of the whole amount which may be received for the transportation of passengers on said railroad company by said company, during the six months last preceding, and it shall be the duty of the President or chief officer of the said Railroad Company to exhibit on oath or affirmation to the Governor on the first Wednesday of January, in each and every year an account showing the gross amount received by said Company, for the transportotion of passengers on said road, and the State proportion thereof, shall be paid into the the State Treasury semi-annually on the first Wednesday of January and July in each year,"

The question upon its adoption was determined in the negative.

Mr. Carroll submitted an amendment;

Which was read and adopted.

The bill was then read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading, and

On motion of Mr. Trail,

Was read the third time by special order, and passed by yeas and nays as follow:
