Strike out after the word "amount" in line 8, to "provided" in line 10, and insert the following "of the bonds and registered debt owing by the State on the first day of November, 1864, or to sell the same and receive in payment the bonds and registered debt owing by the State on the first day of November, 1864, equal in amount to the price obtained for the same;

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Tome moved to reconsider the vote adopting the amendment,
