The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following message:

BY THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,

March 23d, 1865.

Gentlemen of the Senate :

The House of Delegates have received your message, asking a committee of Conference on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses upon the amendments of the House of Delegates to the bill to enable the Banks and Banking Institutions of this State to become associations for the purpose of banking under the laws of the United States, and concur therein.
