

Strike out all after the word "that," in line 1st, section 5, and insert the following: "the said Officers of Registration shall register the names of every white male person who shall apply for registration, in the several wards or election districts in which such person is resident, and after recording the surname and christian name, shall administer to such person the oath of allegiance, as prescribed by the fourth section of Article first of the Constitution, and the further oath that he is a white male citizen of the United States, of the age of twenty-one years or upwards, and that he has resided or will have resided in the State one year next preceding the election succeeding the date of the registry, and six months in the county or Legislative districts of Baltimore city, in which he applies for registration, and that he has not been convicted of larceny or other infamous crime, whereof the Governor has not pardoned him; and that he has not been convicted under the fifth section of Article 1 of the Constitution, and they are hereby directed and required, upon the person taking the said oath, to enter in a column the fact that such person has been sworn as a qualified voter;"

Mr. Clarke submitted the following:

Amend section 5, by striking out all after the word "enacted," and insert, "that the said officers of registration shall register the name of every white male citizen of the United States, of the age of twenty-one years or upwards, residents of their wards or election districts, who shall have resided in the State one year next preceding the election next hereafter to be held, and six months in the county or ward of Baltimore city, subject to the following exceptions, conditions, restrictions and penalties:"

1st. No person shall be registered who has been convicted of larceny or other infamous crime, unless he shall have been
