

with the consent and approval of the proper authorities of the said United States.

BOOKS, ACCOUNTS, ROLLS AND RETURNS.

SECT. 165.—Each district commandant shall constantly keep a correct register of the volunteer companies within his military district, showing the date of organization, names of officers with the date of their commissions, and the name, age, residence and date of enlistment, and whether by volunteering or by draft, of every member of said companies.

SECT. 166.—The said register shall also contain the name, age, residence and date of enlistment of all persons enrolled within his district who are members of companies organized in other districts, together with a designation of the respective companies in which they may have enlisted.

SECT. 167.—Each district commandant shall return a copy of this register carefully revised, to the adjutant general on or before the 1st day of October, annually.

SECT. 168.—He shall also keep an order-book, in which he shall record orders received and issued.

Account of Military Fund.

SECT. 169.—Each district commandant shall, on or before the 1st day of May, and 1st day of November, in each year, transmit a full and detailed account to the paymaster general of all monies received and disbursed by him since the last report, accompanied by the proper receipts and other vouchers, and shall, at the time of making said accounts, unless otherwise ordered by the commander-in-chief, pay over to the paymaster general whatever balance may remain in his hands for the use of the general military fund.

Rosters.

SECT. 170.—The adjutant of each regiment or battalion shall keep a roster of his command, and in like manner the assistant adjutant general of each brigade and division, when the same shall be organized; and an order-book in which they shall record orders received and issued.

Company Returns to District Commandant.

SECT. 171.—Commanders of volunteer companies shall transmit on or before the 1st day of September, annually, to the several district commandants a return showing the name, age and date of enlistment, and whether by volunteering or by draft, of each member of their company residing within the limits of the several military districts of said commandants respectively.

Company Returns to Adjutant General.

SECT. 172.—Each company commander shall transmit to the adjutant general, annually, on or before the 1st day of
