each name the number of days duty performed by each, and the amount of pay each is entitled to receive for such service, and if a mounted company or detachment, whether said members were provided with serviceable horses, and shall also set forth opposite to the name of each member of his company whether such member is indebted to his company, or to the military fund on account of fines or other stoppages, and the cause and amount of such indebtedness, and shall transmit the said pay roll, certified on his oath to be correct and true, and approved by the commanding officer of said camp or post, or by the president of said court martial, or officer to whom said guard was ordered to report, to the paymaster general, within ten days after the expiration of said tour of duty.

Pay Roll of Officers.

SECT. 202.—The commanding officer of each camp or post shall, also, at the close of the time for which each company, battery, squadron, battalion or regiment shall have been ordered to attend for duty thereat, make or cause to be made a complete roster or list of all commissioned officers and noncommissioned staff officers who shall have appeared and performed duty thereat, uniformed, armed and equipped, as hereinbefore provided, and shall set opposite each name the number of days duty performed by each, and the amount of pay each is entitled to receive for such service, after the deductions of fines or other stoppages as mentioned in the preceding section, and shall transmit said pay roll, verified by his oath to be correct and true, to the paymaster general, within ten days after the expiration of said tour of duty.

Pay Roll of Courts Martial.

SECT. 203.—The pay roll of the members and officers of general courts martial, including the officers of the provost guard, shall in like manner be made out by the judge advocate, verified by his oath, and authenticated by the president of the court.

Payment to be provided for.

SECT. 204.—The paymaster general shall, under the direction of the commander-in-chief, prescribe such further rules and regulations to provide for the more convenient payment, out of the military fund, of all sums which may become due to officers, non-commissioned officers and privates as may be deemed necessary to facilitate the execution of the foregoing provisions, and shall also prepare the necessary blanks of pay rolls and other forms, and cause the same to be transmitted to the commanding officers hereinbefore mentioned
