Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report an Act to add to Article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, "Crimes and Punishments" an additional section relating to larceny.

On motion of Mr. Maund,

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings, to report an Act to amend the thirteenth section of Article twenty-four of the Code of Public General Laws relating to Conveyancing.

Mr. Ohr from the committee on Elections reported a bill entitled, an Act to add an additional Article to the Code of General Laws entitled, Registration;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Ohr from a Select committee reported a bill relating to summoning and drawing Jurors in Allegany county;
