A bill entitled, an Act empowering Thomas Watts and others to sell Cullison Meeting House in Baltimore county ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings;

A bill entitled, an Act to amend the Act of 1864, chapter 289, entitled, an Act to incorporate the Franklin and Powhatan Passenger Railway company ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements;

A bill entitled, an Act to change the name of John Young, of Baltimore city, to Marshall Young ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Baltimore city Senators;

A bill entitled, an Act to consolidate the Bankers and Brokers Telegraph companies of New York, Pennsylvania and New Jersey ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements;

A bill entitled, an Act for the relief of the Baltimore Orphans' Asylum ;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee upon that subject.

On motion of Mr. Tome,

Leave was granted the committee on Finance to report a bill to repeal section six, Article eighty-one, of the Public General Laws, relating to tax on Slaves.
