Henry Kearney, white, convicted in Frederick county, March, 1850, and sentenced for 17 years, died June 30th, 1864, of Phthisis, aged 50 years. This man was pronounced a consumptive when he entered the prison, and was an inmate of the Hospital during the fifteen months immediately preceding his death.

In the Female Department of the prison, one death and one birth occurred during the year.

Martha Woods, colored, convicted in Baltimore city, October, 1863, and sentenced for 4 years, died December 15th, 1863, of Meningitis, aged 17 years.

Charlotte Stanley, colored, convicted in Dorchester county, November, 1863, gave birth to a son, Charles Stanley, January 15th, 1864.
