

issued, and whatever bounties or arrearages of bounty still remain to be paid under the provisions of that Act, shall be paid out of the proceeds of the loan hereby authorized.

“Section 7. And be it further enacted, That the Mayo and-City Council of the city of Baltimore, and the County Commissioners of the several counties, be and are hereby authorized to raise by loan such sum or sums as may be necessary to pay to each volunteer or drafted man the sum of two hundred dollars in addition to the State bounty as provided for in the previous sections of this Act for the purpose of filling the quota of the several counties and of the city of Baltimore, under the call of the President of the United States for three hundred thousand men dated December 1864.

“Section 8. And be it further enacted, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the County Commissioners of the several counties aforesaid, are hereby prohibited from levying or paying any larger sum than is hereinbefore provided for in section 7 of this Act.

“Section 9. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the day of its passage.”

The amendments were ordered to be printed.
