The payments to the Volunteers, under the Acts of 1864, chapters 15, 246 and 373, since 22nd March last to 30th September, 1864, amounted in the whole to the sum of \$1,281,668.90; exceeding by the sum of \$755,483.90 the amount realized by the issue and sale of stock authorized for the payment of the said bounties, from which latter sum deduct the sum of \$195,198.98 realized for bounty taxes received from Collectors in the counties and city of Baltimore, and taxes on incorporated institutions and taxes on stocks, and there will still be a balance of \$560,286.92 paid out of the Treasury over and above the amount received for the stock issued, and all other sources of revenue under the Act of 1864, aforesaid.
