Strike out all in section 2, after the word "the," in line 7, and insert, "County Commissioners of the several counties, and Mayor of Baltimore city, they shall thereupon furnish a copy of the same to every person drafted and held to service, or to every person volunteering or furnishing a representative substitute, which certificate, on presentation to the Comptroller of the Treasury shall authorize him to issue his warrant for the payment of the bounty provided for in section 1 of this Act, to every person drafted and held to service, and to every person volunteering or furnishing a representative substitute as the case may be, and said County Commissioners and Mayor of Baltimore city shall receive — dollars for the performance of the duties required by this Act ;
