The Senate of Maryland:

The committee on Elections, to which was referred the message of His Excellency, the Governor, transmitting the returns of the election of members of the Senate, have had that subject under consideration and would respectfully report:

That from these returns for Senators, in Allegany county, Charles H. Ohr, had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Anne Arundel county, Sprigg Harwood, had the highest number of votes and was elected; in the First Legislative District of Baltimore city, Robert Turner had the highest number of votes and was elected; in the Second Legislative District of said city, Joseph C. Whitney had the highest number of votes and was elected; in the Third Legislative District of said city, George C. Maund had the highest number of votes and was elected; that in Baltimore county, Edward P. Philpot had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Calvert county, Richard Mackall had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Caroline county, Curtis Davis had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Carroll county, James L. Billingslea had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Cecil county, Jacob Tome had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Charles county, John W. Jenkins had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Dorchester county, Dr. Thomas King Carroll had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Frederick county, Charles E. Trail had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Harford county, Wm. B. Stephenson had the highest number of votes and was elected; in Howard county, Hart B.
