Ordered, That there be printed, for the use of the Senate, the usual copies of the Rules of the Senate, to which shall be attached the forms prescribed in the joint report of the General Assembly, made at the January session, 1860, making the legislation of the State conform to the provisions of the Constitution and the Code of Laws of this State, and that the said forms be made the standing rule of the Senate in reference to the subject matter thereof.
