The bill entitled, An act to divide election district No. 2, in Frederick county, into two polls, and to repeal an act passed by the General Assembly on the 25th day of June, 1861, chapter 74, entitled, An act to divide the western poll of district No. 2, in Frederick county, into two polls ;
