Mr. Eichelberger submitted the following amendment :

Amend section 42 by adding after the word “license” in the 10th line the following : “and shall be liable to be sued therefor in any of the courts of this State ;”

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Eichelberger submitted the following amendment :

Amend by striking out the words “section 2” and substitute “and that ;”

Which was read and adopted.
