On motion of Mr. Eichelberger,

The Senate reconsidered the vote upon rejecting the bill, and It was referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, An act to carry into effect the bequest of freedom to certain slaves, made by the last will and testament of John Randall, late of the city of Annapolis, deceased, by authorizing his widow, executrix and residuary legatee, to manumit said slaves;

Referred to the committee on Colored Population.

A bill entitled, An act appropriating a sum of money for the repair of the Government House and for the purchase of furniture therefor;

Which was read the first time, and

Referred to the committee on Finance.

Also, returned the bill entitled, An act to authorize Charles Beall, of Prince George's county, to act in the double capacity of magistrate and postmaster:

Endorsed "passed by yeas and nays."

The bill entitled, An act to authorize the county commissioners of Frederick county to exempt certain bonds from taxation for certain purposes;

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, An act for the relief of Robert Thompson, James R. Thompson and Ford Combs;

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, An act to pay G. W. Jefferson, for extra clerical services in the Executive Department,

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading,

The bill entitled, An act to change the name of Samuel Edwin Ridout Hyde, to Samuel Ridout Hyde,

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follow:
