D. P. Runner, Committee Clerk, appeared, qualified, and entered upon the discharge of his duties.

Mr. Goldsborough, of Dorchester, submitted the following order:

The rules were suspended and the order adopted.

On motion of Mr. Everett,

Ordered, That when the Senate adjourns, it adjourn to meet on Monday at one o'clock, P. M.

On motion of Mr. Eichelberger,

Ordered, That Messrs. Schley & Cole be and they are hereby appointed Printers to the Senate; and that the committee on Printing contract with them for the same.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a bill entitled, An act to authorize the commissioners of Montgomery county to raise money for the purpose of building a jail.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs Waters, Harrison and Jenkins.

Mr. Goldsborough, of Dorchester, from the select committee, submitted the following report:

The committee appointed to consider and report rules for the regulation of the Senate, respectfully recommend the adoption of the rules by which the Senate was governed at the last regular session.

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Smith, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Home Missionary Society of the Maryland Annual Conference of the Methodist Protestant Church.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

The Senate adjourned until Monday at one o'clock.
