A bill entitled, An act to divide election district No. 2 in Frederick county, into two polls, and to repeal an act passed by the General Assembly on the 25th day of June, 1861, chapter 74, entitled, An act to divide the western poll of district No. 2, in Frederick county, into two polls.

A bill entitled, An act to make valid certain deeds from Thomas James Reddit, known as James Reddit, Jr., of Dorchester county, to James Reddit, of Dorchester county.

A bill entitled, An act to refund to Samuel T. Hopkins and John Donovan certain moneys overpaid by them into the State Treasury.

Severally endorsed "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, An act to make valid a deed from George W. Pembroke, executor of George Beal, to John H. Tucker.

A bill entitled, An act to add an additional section to article 2, of the Code of Public General Laws, in relation to abatements.

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the vestry of St. Paul's Parish, in Kent county, to acquire and hold real estate not exceeding one hundred and twenty acres.

Referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to authorize the Comptroller to employ an additional clerk for a limited time.

A bill entitled, An act to allow Joshua W. Philips, late sheriff and collector of Somerset county, further time to complete his collections and to give him power to do so;
