Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to be entitled, An act supplementary to an act entitled, An act to incorporate the Merchants Mutual Insurance Company of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Sellman,

Leave was granted the committee on Finance to report a bill entitled, An act appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the Delegates, appointed by the late Executive of this State to represent the State of Maryland in the Peace Conference, for expenses incurred and services rendered by them whilst attending said Peace Conference.

Mr. Goldsborough, of Dorchester, from the select committee reported a bill entitled, An act to amend the 98th article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Wild Fowl, by adding a section thereto;

Which was read the first time.

The hour having arrived for considering the Order of the Day, the President announced the bill entitled, An act to repeal section 177, of article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Guardian and Ward, and to enact the following in lieu thereof;
