A bill entitled, An act to amend the 60, 61, 69, 73, 74, 75, 76, 86 and 89th sections, relating to licenses for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, of article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws;

Which was read the first time, and Referred to the committee on Finance, and Ordered to be printed.

On motion of Mr. Eichelberger, The Senate granted him leave of absence. The Senate adjourned.
