A bill entitled, An act to repeal the 55, 56 and 57th sections of article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the collection districts of Baltimore county, and to insert in lieu thereof the following sections;

Which was read the first time, and

Referred to Messrs. Lynch, Smith and Harrison.

Mr. Goldsborough, of Dorchester, submitted the following message:
