Goldsborough, of Dorchester, Lankford and Blackiston, to report a bill to amend the 20th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by repealing the 31, 32, 33 and 37th sections thereof, and substituting and adding other sections, in relation to the town of Easton, in Talbot county.

Mr. Goldsborough, of Dorchester, presented the petition of citizens of Dorchester county, against the passage of the law appropriating fifty thousand dollars for the relief of the volunteers;
