Also, returned a bill entitled, An act to amend the law relating to indictments by adding to the 13th article of the Code of Public General Laws the following sections relating to indictments for forging or altering forged instruments and for false pretenses, and to the description of instruments in any indictment so as to promote the ends of justice that cases may be tried on their merits;

Endorsed " passed by yeas and nays with proposed amendments:"

"At the end of the 1st section add the following proviso: ' provided that nothing herein contained shall apply to offences committed before the passage of this act;'"

"Amend the title by inserting the word 'Code,' so as to read the Code of Public General Laws;"

" In the 8th line of the 1st section after the word ' person,' insert 'with like intent;'"

" In the 7th line of the 1st section after the word ' State ' insert 'or any note or notes if issued as currency by the United States;'"
