Referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, An act to repeal section 101 of article 26 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Corporations, and to insert in lieu thereof one other section defining more certainly the rights intended to be secured to the Protestant Episcopal Church ;

Which was read the first time, and

Referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, An act to amend section 188 of article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws for Allegany county, relating to wild animals in said county ;

Which was read the first time, and

Referred to Messrs. Everett, Bayne and Lankford.

A bill entitled, An act to repeal so much of article 4 of the Code of Public General Laws as relates to the inspection of tobacco, commencing with section 495 and ending with section 551 of said article, both inclusive, and making other provisions therefor ;

Which was read the first time, and

Referred to the committee on Agriculture.

Mr. Eichelberger submitted the following order :
