After a time the Senate resumed the consideration of Legislative business.

On motion of Mr. Briscoe,

Ordered, that the members of the Senate, who were not members of the last General Assembly of Maryland, of 1860, be permitted to retain the copies of the Code furnished them by the Librarian under a former order of this House.

The bill entitled, An act to amend article 90 of the Code of Public General Laws by adding thereto the following sections in relation to supervisors of roads;

Was read the third time;

Mr. Eichelberger moved to strike out the enacting clause; Determined in the affirmative by yeas and nays, as follow:
