

Add to section 6 the following proviso:

“Provided further, that if the owners of the present Patapsco Bridge at Elkridge Landing, should be willing to sell the same with its appurtenances, at a valuation to be made by arbitrators to be mutually agreed on, it shall be incumbent on the corporation hereby constituted, to purchase the said bridge instead of constructing a new bridge, in which case the capital stock of the corporation hereby constituted, shall be the cost of said Patapsco Bridge and appurtenances.

Which was read and determined in the negative, and
