

Mr. Eichelberger, from the select committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, An act to authorize David Eyler, of school district No. 89, in Frederick county, to sell and convey to any purchaser, all that lot of land called "Simon's Delight," which was conveyed to him by Catharine Weller, for a site for a school house, reported it without amendment.

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Eichelberger, from the select committee, to which was referred the bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 11, 12 13, 14 and 16th of article 55 of the Code of Public General Laws, and chapter 47 of the acts of the special session of the General Assembly, 1861, relating to the duties of State Librarian and to substitute therefor the following, reported it without amendment.

The bill was then read the second time.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a bill entitled, An act to repeal section 30 of article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the compensation of the State's Attorney for Dorchester county, and to substitute therefor the following;

Said bill was then returned to the House of Delegates.
