The bill entitled, An act to regulate the meetings of the Commissioners of Public Works, and to authorize them to employ counsel in certain cases;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading, and to be printed.

On motion of Mr. Everett,

Leave was granted Messrs. Everett, Firey and Townsend, to report a bill to alter and amend the charter of the Cumberland Coal and Iron Company.

The bill entitled, An act to repeal the 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16th sections of article 84 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to schools;

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Everett, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, An act to alter and amend an act passed January session, 1852, chapter 93, entitled, an act to alter and amend the charter of the Cumberland Coal and Iron Company, passed December session, 1840, chapter 214;

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Billingsley,

Leave was granted the committee on Finance to report a bill for the relief of the securities on the official bond of Thompson Abell, collector of the State tax for the years 1850, '51 and '52.
