## XXXV.

*A Form where a New Article is to be added to the Code.*

A BILL entitled, An Act to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws for (whatever may be the subject.)

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following Article be added to the Code of Public General Laws:*

SECTION 1.

SECTION 2, and so on.

*A Form where an Article is to be Amended by adding New Sections.*

A BILL entitled, An Act to add the following Sections, relating to (here describe the subject of the Sections) Article \_\_\_\_\_, of the Code of Public General Laws:

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, (here state the subject under Section, numbering them 1, 2, &c.)*

*A Form where a Section or Sections is or are to be Amended relating to the same subject.*

A BILL entitled, An Act to amend the 5th and 6th Sections relating to (here describe the subject,) of Article ten of the Code of Public General Laws:

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the 5th and 6th sections of Article 10, of the Code of Public General Laws, (relating to, &c.,) be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor.*

Sometimes it may be designed to repeal a Section of a Public Local Law, and make it a General Law; when this is the case, the Public Local Law on that subject must be repealed.

If the Sections embrace more than one subject, they must be in separate bills.
