Mr. Smith submitted the following resolution:

Resolved by the General Assemby of Maryland, That the joint resolution heretofore passed authorizing the Governor to appoint commissioners to an International Convention to be held in London in 1862, be and the same is hereby rescinded and repealed;

Which was read the first time, and

On motion of Mr. Briscoe,

Referred to the committee on Agriculture.

The Senate adjourned.

FRIDAY, January 10th, 1862.

On motion of Mr. Eichelberger,

Leave was granted the committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill to repeal sections 1, 2 and 7 of article 52 of the Code of Public General Laws, and to provide for the keeping of the records of the Court of Chancery.
