

the State's subscription to the stock of said company, until it shall be legally ascertained and declared by said judicial tribunals or by a new election, who are the duly elected officers of said company, and to whom such payment should be made; and that the the records, books, papers, seal and other property of said company, now in the charge of the committee of investigation heretofore appointed by this House, be returned to the custody and keeping of the person or persons, who delivered the same to the said committee; and that thereupon the said committee be discharged from the further consideration of the subject.
