On motion of Mr. Davis, of Montgomery,

Leave was granted the Montgomery and Howard county delegations to introduce a bill to repeal an act, chapter 153, entitled, An act to authorize the opening of a public road in Howard and Montgomery counties.

Mr. Magruder, from a select committee, reported favorably the following bill, entitled, An act to amend section 13 of article 98 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Wild Fowl, relating to the catching and killing of partridges;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Alexander, from a select committee, reported favorably the bill entitled, An act to ratify the purchase, and to provide for the organization and government of Druid Hill Park and Patterson Park, belonging to the city of Baltimore, by incorporating certain additional sections in article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws;

Which was read the first time, and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Price, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported unfavorably upon the bill entitled, An act to amend the 72d section of article 75 of the Code of Public General Laws, as far as the same relates to the removal of causes from the Criminal Court of Baltimore city;

In which report the House concurred.
