Also, delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, An act to provide for the holding of corporation elections in Frederick city;

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Frederick county delegation.

A bill entitled, An act to alter and amend an act passed January session, 1852, chapter 93, entitled, An act to alter and amend the charter of the Cumberland Coal and Iron Company, passed December session, 1840, chapter 214;.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Also, the following message:

By the Senate,

January 7, 1862.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:

We have received your message, proposing the appointment of a committee of the two Houses to wait on the Honorable Augustus W. Bradford, Governor elect of this State, and request his attendance on Wednesday, the 8th instant, at 12 o'clock, in the Senate Chamber, to qualify according to the Constitution and form of government of this State, and concur therein.

We have appointed Messrs. Goldsborough, Bayne and Sellman, on the part of the Senate, to unite with the gentlemen appointed by your Honorable Body.
