

A deputation on the part of the Honorable the Senate appeared in the Hall of the House, and through their chairman, the Hon. C. F. Goldsborough, announced that the Governor elect, was present in the Senate Chamber and ready to take the oath of office as prescribed by the Constitution of the State, and the Senate were waiting the presence of the House.

Whereupon the members of the House preceded by the Speaker, retired to the Senate Chamber.

After the delivery of his Inaugural Address, the oath of office was administered to the Hon. Augustus W. Bradford, Governor elect, by the Hon. Richard I. Bowie, Chief Justice of the Court of Appeals, agreeably to the Constitution and Laws.

The members of the House, preceded by the Speaker, returned to their Hall; when

His Excellency, Governor Bradford, through Mr. Johnson, of Baltimore county, tendered to the Speaker and the Members of the House of Delegates, an invitation to call upon him at the Executive Mansion this afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Which invitation was accepted.
