

Mr. Smyth, from a select committee, reported favorably the bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 387, 388, 389, 396 and 397, of article 4th, of the Code of Public Local Laws, and substitute and add the following;

Which was read the first time.

The bill entitled, An act to authorise the Treasurer of the State, to pay on the warrant of the Comptroller to the Treasurer of the Maryland Colonization Society, the sum appropriated by chapter 425, of the act of Assembly of January session, 1858;

Was read the second time.

The bill entitled, An act to amend an act entitled, A further supplement to the act passed at January session 1860, chapter 196, changing the commissioners appointed by the act of 1858, chapter 178, for cleaning out Pocomoke river;
