

second word "Jurors" in the 59th line, and insert: "the sheriff shall, at least thirty days before the session of the Circuit Court for each county, respectively, select from the list of legal voters of such county, in such proportion for each district, as may be deemed proper, the names of one hundred persons, to serve (if summoned) as grand jurors, and also the names of one hundred other persons to serve (if summoned) as petit jurors; there shall be provided for each district two boxes, one of which shall be marked or labelled grand jurors, and the other, petit jurors, and each, with the name of the district.

"The names of the persons selected, as aforesaid, shall be written each on a separate ballot, and the ballots shall be folded so as to conceal the names written upon them.

"Those containing the names of persons selected for grand jurors shall be deposited in the boxes marked grand jurors, the names selected from each district being placed in the box of that district; in like manner the names of the persons selected for petit jurors shall be deposited in the boxes marked petit jurors, the names of each district being placed in the box of that district; after which the boxes shall be locked and delivered to the county commissioners, who shall, within ten days after the delivery of the said boxes as above provided, meet in the commissioners office and, first shaking the boxes so as to intermix the ballots, shall, in the presence of such persons as may choose to be present, draw from the box marked grand jurors, in the same proportion for each district in which they were selected by the sheriff, the names of twenty-three persons to be summoned as grand jurors for that term. At the same time the commissioners in like manner shall draw from the boxes marked petit jurors, in the same proportion for each district in which they were selected by the sheriff, the names of twenty-five persons to serve as petit jurors. The sheriff shall at least ten days before the session of the court summon the said forty-eight persons to serve as jurors;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Creswell proposed the following amendment:

"Strike out the word 'three' in the 8th line and in lieu thereof insert the word 'two;'"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Magruder proposed the following:

After the word commissioners in the 12th line add: "the said county commissioners before they shall proceed to make out the said list, shall take and subscribe the following oath before some justice of the peace of the county, 'we do swear
