

On motion of Mr. Davis, of Montgomery,

Ordered, That a select committee, composed of Messrs. Davis, of Montgomery, Warner, Hammond, of Howard, Morton and Purnell, consider and report forthwith upon the application of Brig. Gen. Stone for a prohibition of the sale of intoxicating drinks to soldiers and others within the lines of his command.

On motion of Mr. Warner,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill entitled, An act authorising the Bank of Commerce to cancel four thousand shares of their capital stock.

On motion of Mr. Taylor,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Collateral Bank of Baltimore city.

Mr. Chamberlain submitted the following:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Senators of the State in the Congress of the United States, are hereby instructed, and the Representatives are requested to use all proper exertions to procure a repeal of the Reciprocity Treaty between Great Britain and the United States; and that a copy of this resolution be transmitted immediately after its passage to the said Senators and Representatives;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Federal Relations.
