

Mr. Magruder submitted the following:

Ordered, That the Librarian be directed to furnish the Maryland Hospital with a copy of the Code and the Laws of 1860 and 1861;

On motion of Mr. Creswell,

Leave was granted the Cecil county delegation to report a bill to repeal an act, entitled, An act to incorporate the village of the Rising Sun, in Cecil county, Maryland, passed at January session, 1860, chapter 383; and to repeal the 165, 166, 167, 168, 169, 170, 171, 172, 173 and 174th sections of the 8th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, whereby the provisions of the said act have been incorporated in the Code of Public Local Laws—and to substitute in lieu of said sections, the following sections, incorporating the village of the Rising Sun, in said county.

On motion of Mr. Davis, of Montgomery,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to incorporate the Potomac Improvement Company.

Mr. Warner, from the committee on Corporations, reported favorably a bill entitled, An Act authorising the Bank of Commerce to cancel four thousand shares of their capital stock;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Ensor, from the same committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An Act to change the name of Fell's Point Saving Institution to that of Fell's Point Bank of Baltimore, and to incorporate the same;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Davis, of Montgomery, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to prohibit the sale of intoxicating drinks in this State to soldiers, slaves and free colored persons;

Which was read the first, and by special order a second time,

Mr. Magruder proposed the following:

Section 1, line 5, after the word "person" insert the words "or to any person under the age of twenty-one years;"

Which was adopted.

On motion of Mr. Davis, of Montgomery,

The bill was laid upon the table, and ordered to be printed, and made the Order of the Day for Monday next.
