After the word "the" in 18th line, strike out all to the word "or" in the 20th line and insert, "penitentiary for a term not less than six months nor more than two years;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Harrison proposed the following amendment:

After the word "time" in the 19th line, insert "not less than six months nor exceeding eighteen months;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Magruder proposed the following amendment:

Sub-section 2, line 15, after the word "war," insert the words "and medicines;"

Which was rejected.

On motion of Mr. Price,

The bill was then laid on the table.

On motion of Mr. Dougherty,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means to report a bill authorising the Treasurer of the State of Maryland to refund to William W. Johnston the sum of one hundred and eighty-nine dollars and seventy-seven cents, the same being the amount of taxes by him erroneously paid.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the bill entitled, An act to change the name of Samuel Edwin Ridout Hyde, of Anne Arundel county, to Samuel Ridout Hyde;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

Which was read and referred to the Anne Arundel county delegation.

The bill entitled, An act to amend the 42nd section of article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the granting of licenses to traders.

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays," with proposed amendments.
