Mr. Harris, of St. Mary's, demanded the ayes and nays upon his motion,

Which being sustained,

Insert, after the word "notwithstanding," in the 9th line of the 4th section, "and that they will not buy from, sell for, or deal with, any person or persons who have not taken the oath herein prescribed;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Magruder proposed the following amendment:

Strike out the words "and government," in section 4, line 5; also, the word "States," in line 6, and insert "and of this State," in line 6;

Which was rejected.

The bill, as amended, was then, by special order, read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follow:
