Leave was granted the committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill to make valid a deed from Ira White and wife to Elizabeth Brady, of Cecil county.

On motion of Mr. Bowie, Jr.

Leave was granted to the Prince George's county delegation to bring in a bill authorizing the Governor to issue commissions to the several justices of the peace and constables, elected in the several election districts of Prince George's county.

On motion of Mr. Magruder,

Leave was granted to the Calvert county delegation to introduce a bill to authorize and empower the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Calvert county, to have transcribed and rebound certain land record books of said county, in his said office.

On motion of Mr. Pearce,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to bring in a bill to regulate the terms, and times of meeting, of the Orphan's Court of Baltimore county.

On motion of Mr. Price,

Leave was granted to the committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill to amend the law in relation to appeals.

On motion of Mr. Matthews,

Leave was granted to the committee on Corporations to bring in a bill to be entitled, An act to further amend the charter of the Associated Firemens' Insurance Company of the city of Baltimore.

Mr. Alexander, from a special committee, reported upon a bill, entitled,

An act authorizing the Court of Appeals to hear and determine, at the present term thereof, the appeal of the State of Maryland from an order lately passed by the Circuit Court of Baltimore city in the cause therein, on the information of the State of Maryland against the Northern Central Railway Company and others;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judiciary.
