

Mr. Mathews proposed the following:

In the 2d line, section 1st, strike out "fifty" and insert "one hundred;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Dent proposed:

Insert after the word "volunteers," in 4th line, 1st section, the words, "who are, at the time of enlisting, citizens of the State of Maryland," and strike out the words "who are," in the same line, and insert the word "and;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Mathews proposed:

In 10th and 11th lines, strike out the words, "composed of Benjamin DeFord, George R. Dodge and Sebastian F. Streeter, of the city of Baltimore," and insert after the word "be," in the 10th line, the words "appointed by the Governor;"

Which was rejected; also,

In the 10th and 11th lines, strike out the words, "Benjamin DeFord, George R. Dodge and Sebastian F. Streeter," and insert the words "the Executive committee of the Union Relief Association;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Findlay proposed:

In line 15th, 2d section, strike out the words "six hundred dollars," and insert, "at the rate of six hundred dollars per annum;"

Which was adopted; also,

Section 3d, in line 3d, insert after the word "filled," "or the acting officer of any company not yet filled," and strike out "or of any single company;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Magruder proposed:

At the end of section 3d, add the following: "Provided, that no part of the sum appropriated by this act shall be expended for the relief of the family of any volunteer who was not, at the time of his enlistment, a bona fide resident of this State for a period of not less than six months previously thereto;"
