

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, An act to amend the 15th section, of article 90, of the Code of Public General Laws relating to road supervisors;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Roads and Highways.

A bill entitled, An act to authorise Thomas I. Frazier, guardian of Arthur C. Mitchell, Albert M. Mitchell, Wm. O. Mitchell, Sarah E. Mitchell and John M. Mitchell, of Dorchester county, to execute a deed of conveyance to Charles B. Frazier, for certain real estate in said county:

Which was read and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled, An act to compensate Charles Townsend, for services in taking charge of the Senate Chamber and Committee Rooms during the recess of the Legislature;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Claims.

A bill entitled, An act amendatory of an act passed by the General Assembly at its January session, 1853, chapter 302, incorporating the Frederick and Monocacy Turnpike company;

Which was read and referred to the Frederick county delegation.

Also, returned the following:

The bill entitled, An act for the relief of Maranda Porter and Harriet Porter, of Carroll county;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays;"

The bill entitled, An act to authorise and empower the Hagerstown Savings Bank to retire or cancel a portion of its capital stock;

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendment;"
