Which was read and referred to the Prince George's county delegation.

Mr. Duncan presented the petition of Nathan G. West and others praying the passage of a law, dividing school districts number three and four in Worcester county;

Which was read and referred to the Worcester county delegation.

Mr. Chamberlain presented the memorial of Aza Beall, J. H. Wade and one hundred and eighteen citizens of Frostburg, asking relief for Joseph Romiser;

Which was read and referred to the Allegany county delegation.

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal that Mr. Samuel Rohrer's continued absence from the House is caused by sickness in his family.

On motion of Mr. Wolf,

Leave was granted the committee on Inspections to report a bill to be entitled, An act to alter and amend so much of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the city of Baltimore, as proposes to regulate the inspection of flour in said city, being from section 330 to 353 inclusive.

On motion of Mr. Johnson, of Frederick,

Leave was granted the Frederick county delegation to report a bill placing the Frederick and Harper's Ferry Ridge Road under the supervision of the commissioners of Frederick county and authorising them to make the same annual appropriations as on other county roads.
