

Also, a bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 799 and 802, of article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, in relation to certain nuisances in the city of Baltimore, and to re-enact the same with amendments thereto;

Also, a bill entitled, An act to enlarge the powers of the mayor and city council of Baltimore, in regard to water, by incorporating certain additional sections in article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws;

Which were read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, An act to amend the 38th article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding a section thereto, relating to the fees of officers which amount to over three thousand dollars per annum;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

Mr. Smyth, from the committee on Colored Population, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to amend section 30, of article 47, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Inheritance, regulating the rules of descent;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

The bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Cecil and Harford Counties Boom Company;
