Mr. Duvall, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to define the boundary line between Montgomery and Prince George's counties;

Mr. Herbert, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to amend section 9, of article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the circuit court of Allegany county, and of section 54, of article 21, of said Code relating to the circuit court of Washington county;

Mr. Everhart, from a select committee, reported favorably upon the Senate bill entitled, An act to authorise and empower the burgess and commissioners of Uniontown, in Carroll county, to change the location of a public alley in said town;
