

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bills:

A bill entitled, An act to repeal sections 118, 119, 120, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 126, 127, 128, 129, 130, 131, 132 and 133, of article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, under the title of sheep;

Which was received and referred to a select committee, composed of Messrs. Dove, Morton and John Bowie, Sr.

A bill entitled, An act to authorise the burgesses and commissioners of Emmittsburg to lay additional taxes for the purpose of making an artificial road of stone or sand on the streets of said corporation;

Which was received and referred to the Frederick county delegation.

A bill entitled, An act to allow Robert Bell, late sheriff and collector of State and county taxes for Dorchester county, further time to complete his collections;

Which was received and referred to the Dorchester county delegation.

Also, returned the following House bills:

The bill entitled, an act to amend the 60th section, of the 13th article, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the primary schools of Howard county;

The bill entitled, An act to authorise and empower Gustavus A. T. Wright, collector of school tax in district number thirty-two of Queen Anne's county, to complete his collections;

The bill entitled, An act to amend sections 58, 61, 62, 68 and 69, of article 5, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Calvert county, relating to public schools of said county;

Severally endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays."

Also, the bill entitled, An act to amend sections 53 and 56, of article 66, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Negroes, relating to vagrant free negroes;

Endorsed, "enacting clause stricken out."
