

Also, leave was granted a select committee, composed of Messrs. Hammond, of Howard, McIntire and Kerr, to report a bill entitled, A supplement to an act passed at the present session of the General Assembly, entitled, An act to repeal sections 11, 12, 13, 14 and 16, of article 55, of the Code of Public General Laws, and chapter 47 of the acts of the special session of the General Assembly of 1861, relating to the duties of the State Librarian, and to substitute therefor the following; and to add thereto additional sections, for the proper care of portions of the public buildings, not provided for by said act.
