Mr. Hammond of Frederick, reported favorably upon the Senate bill entitled, An act to authorise the burgess and commissioners of Emmittsburg, to lay additional taxes for the purpose of making an artificial road of stone or sand on the streets of said corporation;

Mr. Everhart, from a select committee, reported favorably upon the Senate bill entitled, An act to add new sections to article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Carroll county, to be called sections 147, 148, 149 and 150, authorising the county commissioners of said county, to have the public roads therein, resurveyed, marked and bounded;

Mr. Burhman, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to repeal so much of the act of 1840, chapter 86, and of the act of 1836, chapter 261, as allows the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, to exceed the maximum of charges established by the original charter of said company, so far as relates to the transportation of certain articles;

Mr. Carroll, from a select committee, reported favorably upon the Senate bill entitled, An act to allow Robert Bell, late sheriff and collector of State and county taxes for Dorchester county, further time to complete his collections;

Mr. Hammond, of Howard, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, An act to protect persons and property passing over the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike Road, by punishing the president, managers and agents of said company;

Also, a bill entitled, An act to authorise and require the Governor to enforce the penalties provided for by the act of 1812, chapter 78, for the failure of the president and managers of the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike, to keep said road in good and proper order;
